- Judges and Classes may be subject to change at the Organiser's discretion.
- You must enter the correct arena at the start of the class – if entering multiple classes, the organisers cannot be held responsible if classes clash.
- Objections shall be made in writing within 30 minutes of the event concerned and lodged with the Secretary together with the sum of £50, which will be refunded if the objection is upheld.
- All riders/exhibitors should be safely and smartly dressed.
- Hats must conform to current BRC rules and must be correctly fastened and worn by competitors at all times whilst mounted.
- Competitors under 16 years old must wear a current standard riding hat, correctly fastened at all times while showing in hand.
- Horses and Ponies are easily spooked and can be dangerous, please avoid behaviour which might alarm them!
